



Manoa Cliff Native Forest Restoration

DIRECTIONS AND OTHER VOLUNTEER INFORMATION

MEETING: Every Sunday at 9:00 AM at the well-marked Manoa Cliff Trailhead where it intersects Roundtop Drive. Directions below.

WHAT TO BRING: Volunteers should be prepared - bring your own water, snacks and, if staying for lunch, bring your own lunch. Also be sure you have appropriate clothing - rain gear, warm clothing and work gloves if you have them. We supply some tools. If you want to stay for lunch, we break at 12:00. You are welcome to stay for as long as you like.

TRAILHEAD LOCATION:

The well-marked/signed Manoa Cliff Trailhead is located on the mauka (uphill) side of the road/parking area, about 4.2-miles up Round Top Drive from Makiki Street. The trail shares the same parking lot with the Moleka Trailhead (which heads makai, downhill).

DRIVING TO THE TRAIL:

The shorter way: To reach the trailhead go mauka on Makiki Street. Mauka of Nehoa St, pass to the right of the long, triangular Board of Water Supply park and continue up as Makiki becomes Round Top Drive. Continue winding up and up until you reach the small parking area on your left, just after 4005 Round Top Drive. The Manoa Cliff Trail (which heads mauka, uphill) shares the same parking lot with the Moleka Trail (which heads makai, downhill).

A longer alternative: To reach the trailhead from Piikoi St heading mauka from central Honolulu, avoid both H-1 on-ramps and continue straight under the H-1 overpass on Piikoi. Shortly thereafter, cross Wilder Ave; Piikoi swings to the left. Almost immediately, turn right on to Mott-Smith Dr., continuing until you turn left on Makiki Heights Dr. Continue until you turn right on Tantalus, and continue winding all the way to the top of Tantalus, which becomes Round Top Dr. Continue on Round Top Dr. until you reach the small parking area on the right-hand side of the road, just before 4005 Round Top Drive. The Manoa Cliff Trail (which heads mauka, uphill) shares the same parking lot with the Moleka Trail (which heads makai, downhill).
